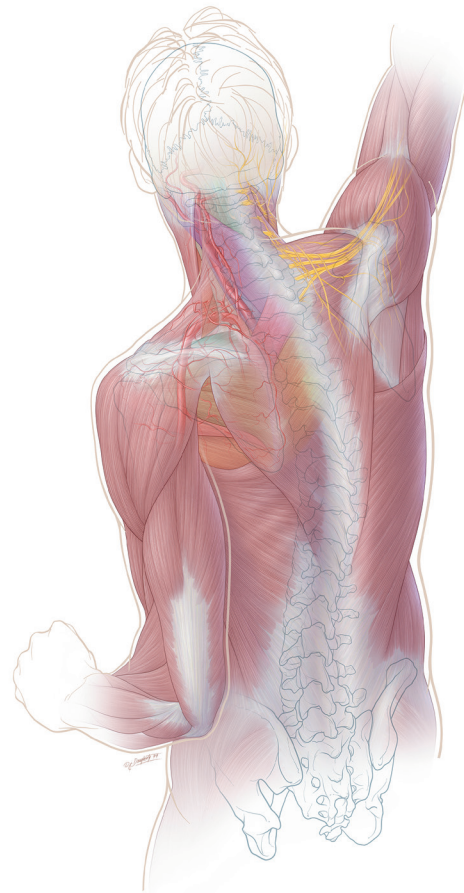

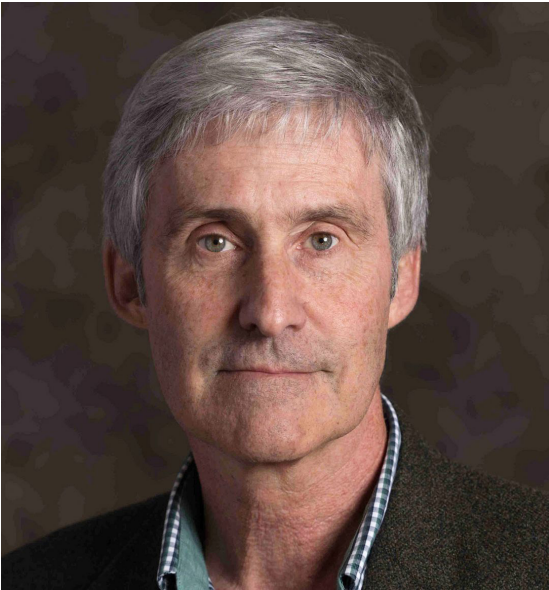

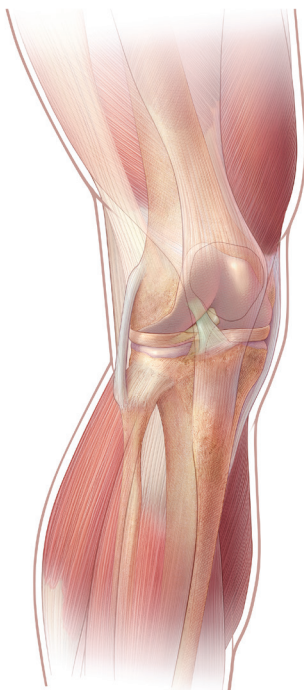


JOHN DAUGHERTY
